What is an Outreach Breakfast?

Partnering with community volunteers and local churches, Seeds of Hope hosts Outreach Breakfasts every Saturday morning to feed and care for the poor and homeless population in Camden.

Where is the Outreach Breakfast located?

The Seeds of Hope Outreach Breakfasts are currently held at the Volunteers of America (VOA) Building: 271 Atlantic Avenue, Camden, NJ.

What time does the Outreach Breakfast start and end?

The Outreach Breakfast starts at 8 am and concludes around 10:45 am.

Where should I park my car?

Cars can be parked along the street outside of the VOA.

What should I wear?

Please dress weather appropriate. Although we serve indoors, it can get cold in the winter and warm in summer. Though it is NOT required, if you happen to have a Seeds of Hope t-shirt, we would love to see you wearing it! (http://www.seedsofhopeministries.org/Merchandise.html)

Will there be a place to store my belongings while I'm serving?

There is a room where volunteers can store their coats and personal belongings (though we recommend that anything valuable be kept on your person or left at home).

Can I bring my children?

Yes. Children ages 8 and up are welcome to participate at the Outreach Breakfasts under the supervision of a legal guardian.

What is the date on which I will be serving?

Seeds of Hope needs volunteers for Outreach Breakfasts every first Saturday of the month. When you register, someone from Seeds of Hope will contact you and schedule you for the next open Saturday that works with your schedule.
