This year's turkey delivery day is <u>Saturday</u>, <u>November 21st</u> and you are invited to help! Please read below:



- 2 Cans of cranberry sauce
- Fresh or canned yams
- Jar of olives
- Pack of biscuits or rolls
- Canned vegetables (corn, string beans, peas, spinach, etc)
- 2 boxed fruit pies
- Pack of Napkins
- Foil turkey pan
- Sturdy box for contents
